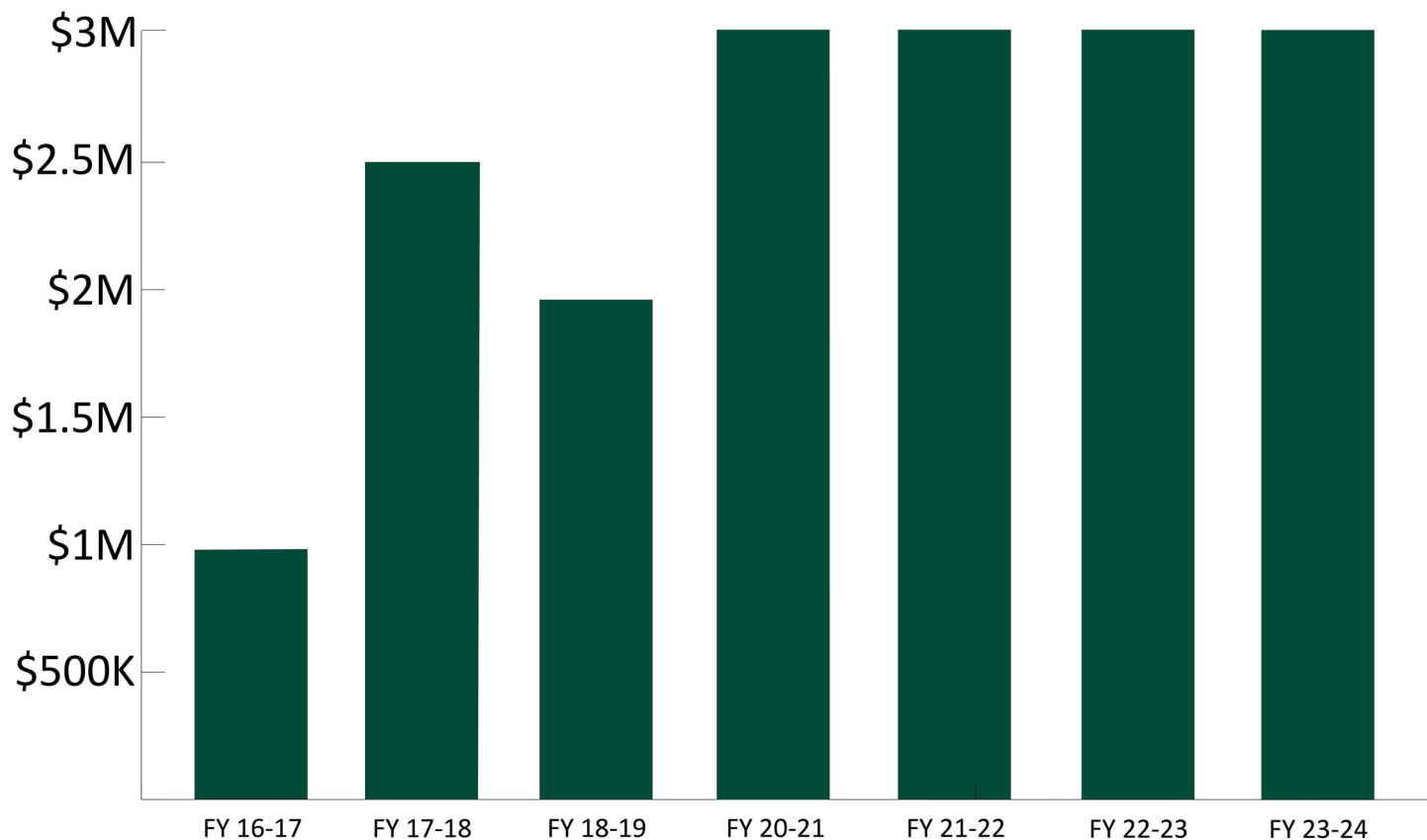


NEW MSU RESEARCH TO EXPLORE INFLUENZA OUTBREAK IN CATTLE
