Jackson College is a Community College serving residents in Jackson, Hillsdale, and Lenawee Counties with quality, transformational educational opportunities and workforce training for modern careers. The main campus, located on a scenic rural site in Jackson County, was constructed during a time of rapid program and enrollment growth in the 1960's and as such, saw rapid growth. Facilities were built at that time to accompany the growth but are now in need of replacement and modernization for several utilities and need updates to the underlying utility infrastructure. The proposed project

will keep the campus safe and operational while preparing for utility renovations to water pipes, sanitary sewer service, and the future relocation of the clock tower on central campus.

- Keep existing site lighting operable where possible and add temporary fixtures where they
  must be removed to obtain access to underground utility
- Utility removals and/or replacements shall be brought back up to safe grading before unfencing the area.
- Alternate walk paths shall be maintained while the site is being modified.
- Cost below includes all required excavation, permitting, and testing.

#### Blue

- Remove and replace 500' of 8" water pipe from SW corner of FH to north side of WA
  - o 8" valves (4)
  - o 12" valves (4)
- Remove and replace 370' of 12" water pipe from NW WA to SE BW and along west side of FH
- Add 4 hydrants

#### Yellow

Remove 8,700 square feet of concrete sidewalk and nearby soil for water pipe replacement

#### Green

• Remove 140 LF of storm pipe and 1 structure and restore to grade

#### Tan

- Abandon sanitary sewer after installing new sanitary piping
- Old 8" clay sanitary sewer line to be lined with resin cure in-place pipelining OR pipe burst and split while pulling through a larger pipe (317 LF)


#### **Orange**

• Place 48" sanitary manhole and 150' of new 8" sanitary

#### Pink

- Site development for center of central mall. Prep to receive clock tower, including footings, drainage, electrical pathways, and plumbing. Temporary walks to be milled limestone until concrete is funded.
- Items not included in this cost:
  - Clock tower refurbishment and relocation.
  - Pavers and other hardscaping not included.
