Currently, the City of Springfield's law enforcement department does not have any ballistic shields. Ballistic shields significantly improve the safety and protection of the sheriff's deputies assigned to the City of Springfield and the public at large during high-risk situations. This project would entail the purchase of four (4) ballistic shields to have

one always kept in each patrol unit so they are readily available by the patrolling deputies should the need arise to use them. Having one in each vehicle would allow the City's law enforcement to be prepared and ready to handle extreme situations before they occur.

This legislative spending does not violate Article 4, Section 30 of the Michigan Constitution because it is going to a city and the funds will be going towards local purposes.
