Dear Applicant:

Based on the information you recently submitted, we have classified your organization as one that is not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code because you are described in section 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

Your exempt status under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization described in 501(c)(3) is still in effect.

This classification is based on the assumption that your operations will continue as you have stated. If your sources of support, or your purposes, character, or method of operation change, please let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on your exempt status and foundation status.

As of January 1, 1984, you are liable for taxes under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) on remunerations of \$100 or more you pay to each of your employees during a calendar year. This does not apply, however, if you make or have made a timely election under section 3121(w) of the Code to be exempt from such tax. You are not liable for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

In the heading of this letter we have indicated whether you must file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax. Since you have been classified as not being a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code, you are also not required to file Form 990-PF, Return of Private Foundation or Section 4947(a)(1) Trust Treated as a Private Foundation.

Grantors and contributors may rely on this determination unless the Internal Revenue Service publishes notice to the contrary. However, if you


lose your section 509(a)(1) status, a grantor or contributor may not rely on this determination if he or she was in part responsible for, or was aware of, the act or failure to act, or the substantial or material change on the part of the organization that resulted in your loss of such status, or if he or she acquired knowledge that the Internal Revenue Service had given notice that you would no longer be classified as a section 509(a)(1) organization.

This supersedes our letter dated May 6, 1994.

Because this letter could help resolve any questions about your private foundation status, you should keep it in your permanent records.
