HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS AND MICHIGAN STATE POLICE

DATE: May 2, 2019

The Subcommittee meeting was called to order by Representative Inman at 9:00 a.m.

Roll was taken: Present - Representatives Inman, VanWoerkom, Albert, Brann, Hood, Tate, Peterson

Absent –

I. House Substitute for HB 4240 (H-1) Draft 1

- A. Representative VanWoerkom moved to place the House Substitute for HB 4240 (H-1) Draft 1 before the House Subcommittee for discussion. The motion passed. Yeas (5) – Representatives Inman, VanWoerkom, Albert, Brann, Tate; Nays (1) – Hood; Absent (1) -- Peterson.
- B. Michael Cnossen from the House Fiscal Agency proceeded to give an overview of the contents of the bill.
- C. Representative Tate moved to amend the bill by adding a \$100 placeholder for the Buddy-to-Buddy veterans program. The motion passed. Yeas (7) – Representatives Inman, VanWoerkom, Albert, Brann, Tate, Peterson, Hood; Nays (0).
- D. Representative Tate moved to amend the bill by restoring a reduction to the IT appropriation. The motion failed. Yeas (3) - Representatives Tate, Peterson, and Hood; Nays (4) - Representatives Inman, VanWoerkom, Albert, and Brann.
- E. Representative Tate moved to amend the bill by restoring an administrative reduction across multiple line items. The motion failed. Yeas (3) - Representatives Tate, Peterson, and Hood; Nays (4) - Representatives Inman, VanWoerkom, Albert, and Brann.
- F. Representative Albert moved to amend the bill by transferring the full \$200,000 amount for targeted grants to the Grand Rapids Home for Veterans. The motion passed. Yeas (7) – Representatives Inman, VanWoerkom, Albert, Brann, Tate, Peterson, Hood; Nays (0).
- G. Representative Brann moved to report the House Substitute for HB 4240 (H-1) as amended out of the House Subcommittee and refer it to the House Standing Committee on Appropriations with recommendation that it pass. The motion passed. Yeas (4) – Representatives Inman, VanWoerkom, Albert, and Brann; Nays (0); Passes (3) Tate, Peterson, and Hood.
