## BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) manages the licensing requirements for emergency medical services, life support agencies, and medical control authorities. The administrative rules incorporate best practices and maintain up to date standards for these services. These rule changes would implement evidence-based practices in accordance with the certificate of need for air ambulance care requirements.

## FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

These rules would likely have no fiscal impact on the state or local units of government. The intent is to remove redundant rules for air ambulance services and streamline the annual licensure processes for life support agencies and vehicles.
