BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2023-49 LR would make numerous amendments and a recission to the rules pertaining to the professional surveyor profession. The changes would revise relicensure continuing education requirements, raising the number of required credit hours from 15 to 30 hours and the number of required hours in professional ethics related to surveying from 1 to 2 hours. The rule set also rescinds a section requiring surveys and drawings that are not boundary surveys to be identified as such.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2023-49 LR is not anticipated to affect the expenditures or revenues of any state or local government units.
