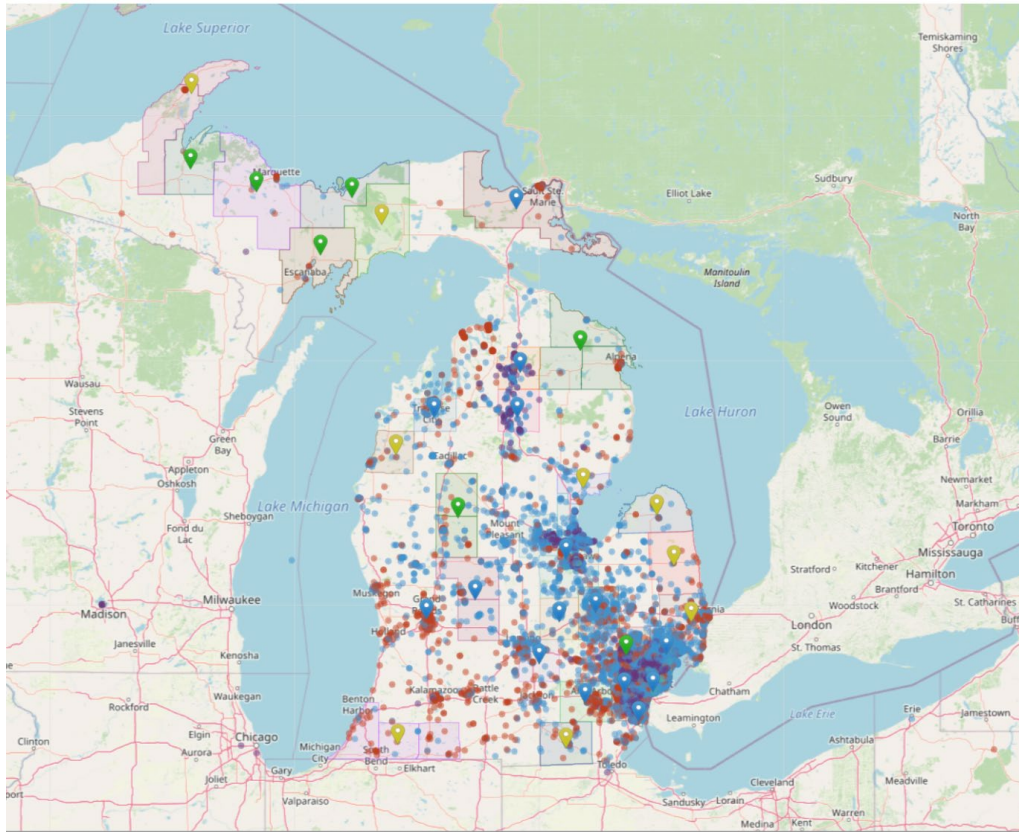

Every month through FAN and all of it's programming.

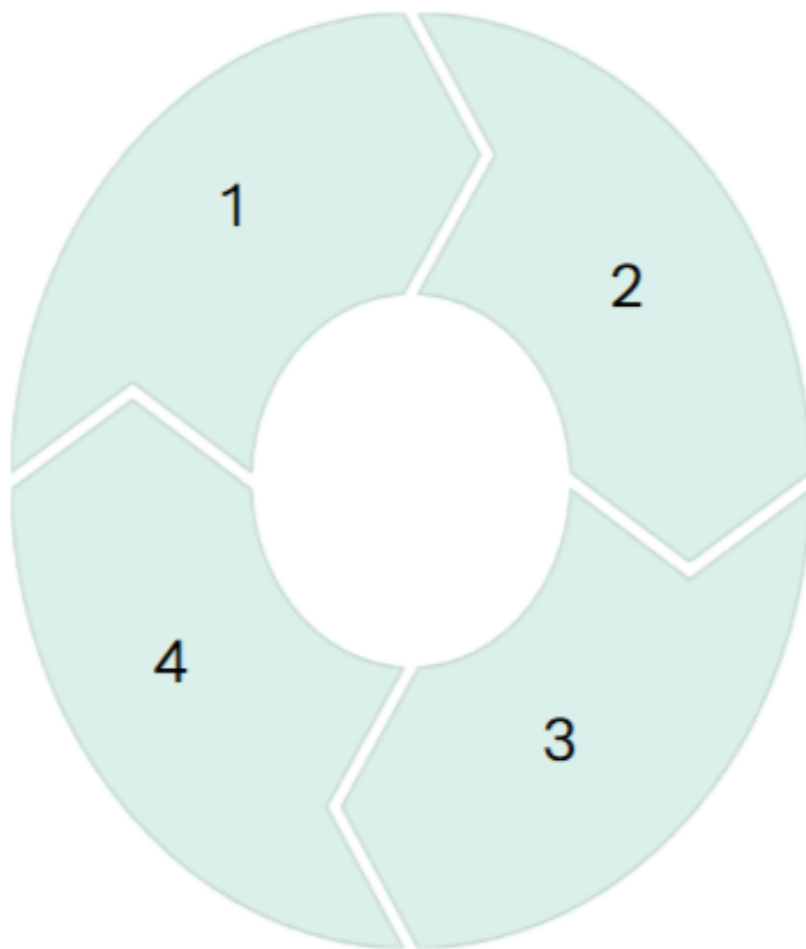
Hope Not Handcuffs: Self-Referral Program

Multi-County Operation

QRTs operate in Macomb, Oakland, Wayne, Bay, Saginaw, and Midland counties.



Collaborative Approach

Teams include law enforcement, peer recovery coaches, and family recovery coaches or case managers.



Comprehensive Support

Offers help with access to treatment, recovery coaching, harm reduction resources, and social services.

Peer Recovery Coaching (PRCs)

Professionally Trained

All PRCs complete two rigorous state-certified trainings to work for FAN.

Personal Experience

PRCs use their firsthand experience of substance use disorder to provide authentic guidance and connection to participants.

Better Recovery Outcomes

This combination of professional training, lived experience, and community-based resources significantly improves chances for successful recovery.



Family Recovery Coaching (FRCs)

Family Support

FRCs provide support and education to family members impacted by a loved one's substance use disorder.

Experienced Guidance

FRCs combine personal experience with family addiction and professional training.

Holistic Approach

Recognizes addiction as a family disease, encouraging everyone to work on their own recovery.



Naloxone Education and Distribution

Free Comprehensive Training

FAN offers naloxone training to individuals and groups at no cost.

Life-Saving Skills

Participants learn signs and symptoms of an overdose and how to properly administer naloxone to reverse overdoses.

Free Kits

Each training includes a naloxone kit for immediate use.

Public Access

Free Narcan dispensers are distributed in public places statewide.



Harmless: Harm Reduction Street Support Team

Harm Reduction

Compassionate, evidence-based approach that prioritizes safety and connection.

Mobile Outreach

Harmless uses the mobile unit to meet people where they are at figuratively and literally.

Essential Supplies

Provides safe use supplies, Narcan, HIV and HEP-C testing, and substance test kits.

Healthcare Access

Partners with Macomb County Street Medicine team for on-site medical care.



Ian:

FAN met me at my lowest—homeless, addicted, and hopeless. I met with their outreach team every week to receive clean supplies and basic medical care. They helped me through countless recovery attempts, jail visits, and job interviews. Their peer coaches showed me what life beyond addiction could look like. Today, I'm a father in recovery, living with purpose. FAN didn't just save my life—they helped me rebuild it.



Zach and Barb

When we first met the FAN outreach team, we were living in a tent and struggling just to survive. Without a phone, we felt trapped and isolated, but Ari and Chelsea from the HARMLESS team, along with our peer recovery coach and case manager, never gave up on us. They brought us a tent twice, gave us sleeping bags during the cold winter months, and encouraged us to believe that we deserved better. With their constant support, we're now five months into recovery, have housing, jobs, and a future filled with hope. I will never be able to repay what they've done for us.

Meetings often feature guest speakers or panel discussions.

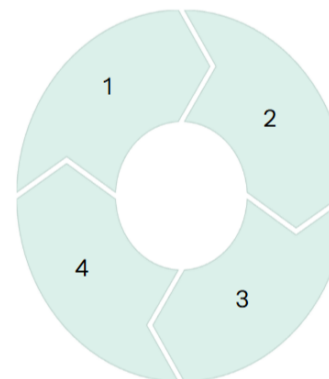
Stronger Together: Addiction Support Group

Up2U Program

Targets 5th and 6th-grade students, offering tools for making healthy decisions under pressure. Partners with law enforcement to deliver six lessons.

"I'm Still A Person" Graphic Novel

Features a graphic novel capturing struggles of young individuals facing addiction. Includes click-and-play lessons and testimonial videos from young people in recovery.
