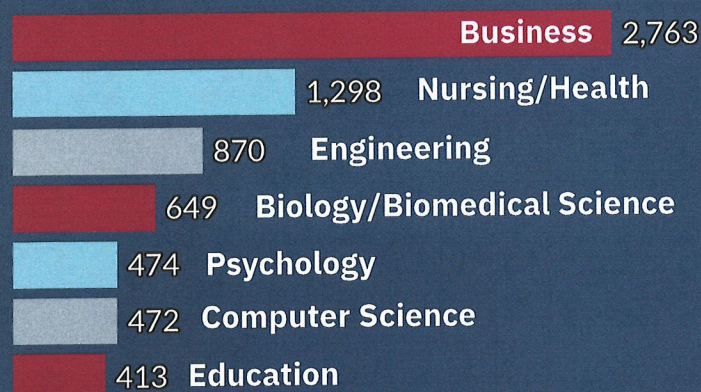

In-Demand Degrees Top Majors for Class of 2024



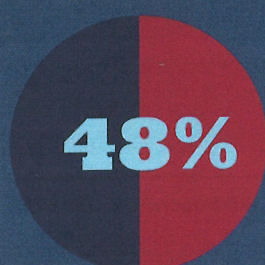

Nearly HALF of adults over 40 who earn a bachelor's degree in Michigan graduated from an independent college or university

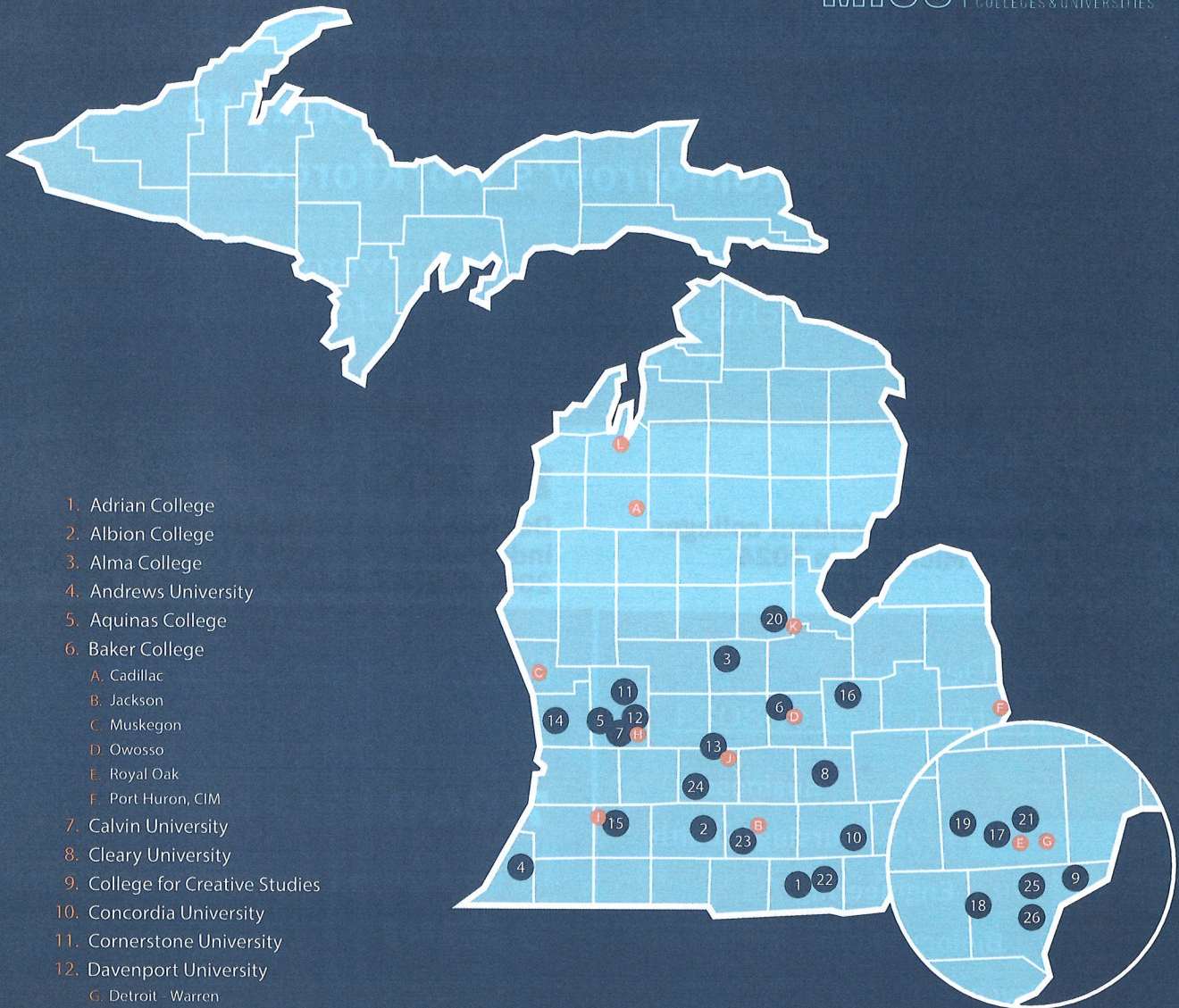
